Walk H

From Hollesey Village

Approximately 3.4 km / 2.1 miles

A short walk along an ancient waterway, and passing an area used as a fair in the middle ages.

1. With your back to School Lane and All Saint's Church turn left along Alderton Road for a very short distance. At the far side of the pink cottage on your right there is a small lane with footpath sign, turn right along this lane until reaching Meadow Farm, which will be on your right.
2. Here there is a junction with other footpaths, turn left and go over footbridge and boards as the ground in this area can be very boggy. Follow the path around to the right, then to the left where it passes into agricultural land.
3. Once in the field the obvious path goes directly across following a rough bit of ground between two fields. Follow this and turn slightly to your right part way along. This brings you to the entrance of Spinney field, go through the gateway and keep close to the trees on your left-hand side.
4. At the junction with the road go straight ahead, which is now the road leading into Shottisham. After a distance you will find The Sorrel Horse on your right, please come in and enjoy some refreshments ready for your journey back.



Please follow the Countryside Code whilst on this walk, especially: -

- Take litter home with you
- Dogs to be kept on leads or close control as there are working farms with livestock in the area
- Take dog excreta away to ensure others can enjoy the walk.
- Do not damage trees and other vegetation as these provide valuable habitat for the wild life.
- Care must be taken on the roads; they are relatively quiet but agricultural vehicles use them at all times of the day.
- Stay on the designated footpaths.
